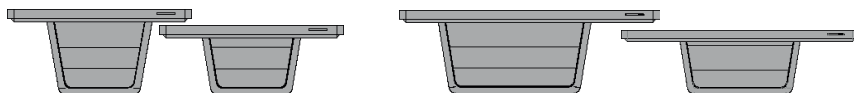

Cobi

Cobi is a piece by American designer Matthew Townsend, who sought to create a new range of coffee tables that would complement several of Manutti's already existing furniture collections. A true example of craftsmanship, Cobi coffee table is beautiful in its standard natural brushed teak or teak scuro finish.

Here is how to start your outdoor moments of peace and connection under the sun.

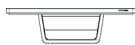
How to assemble the Cobi coffee table

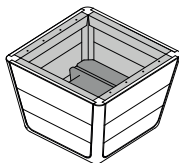

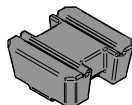

STEP 1: Cobi coffee table base installation: open straps

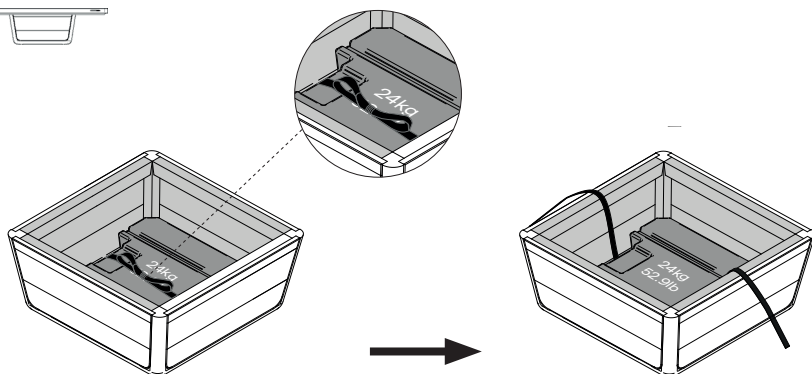

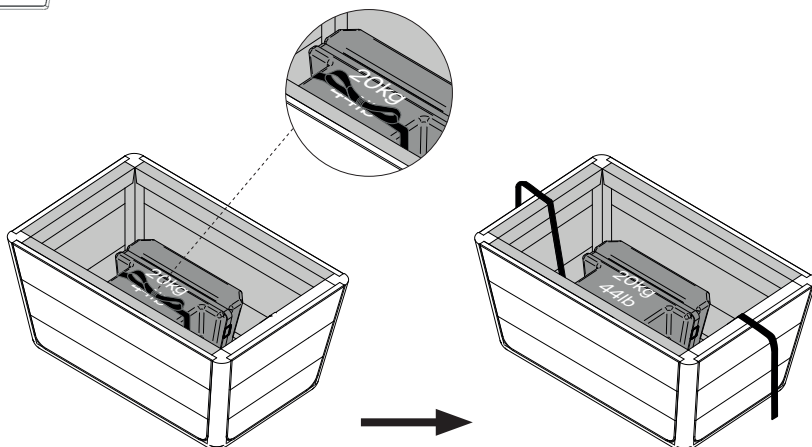


After opening the box of the base, position your base on the desired location. Open the center straps and place them sideways.

STEP 2: Cobi coffee table base installation: extra counterweight

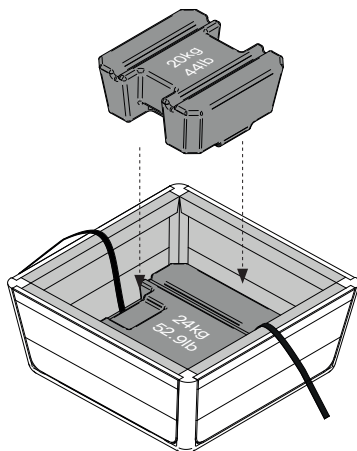

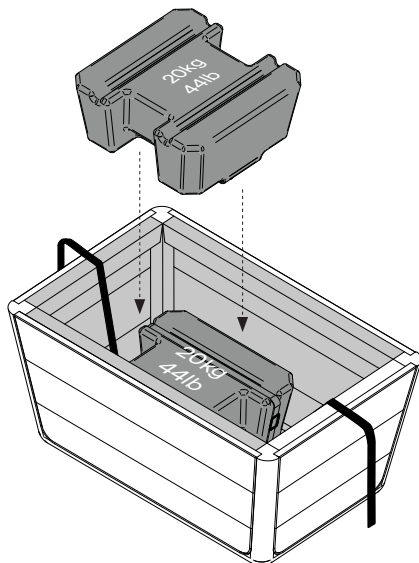


Place the second weight in the teak base ensuring they are aligned and the protrusions of the second weight fit in the cavities of the first weight.

STEP 3: Cobi coffee table base installation: fasten strapping clip

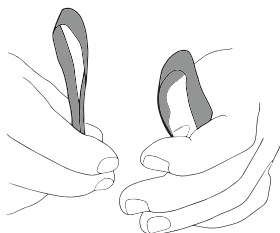

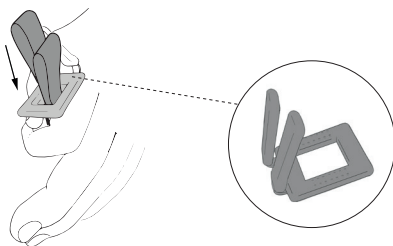

1. First create a loop in each end of the middle strap.



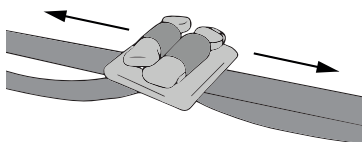
2. Next pass the plastic strapping clip over the two loops as shown.



3. After you have placed the loops inside of the plastic strapping clip, push the two tabs of the strapping clip through the loops.

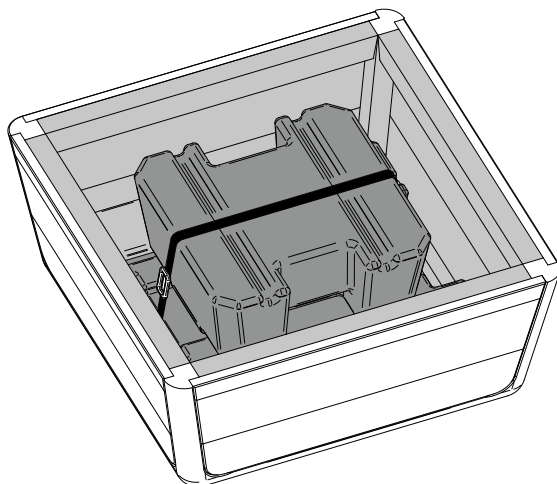


4. Finally pull both loose ends of the strap to tighten.

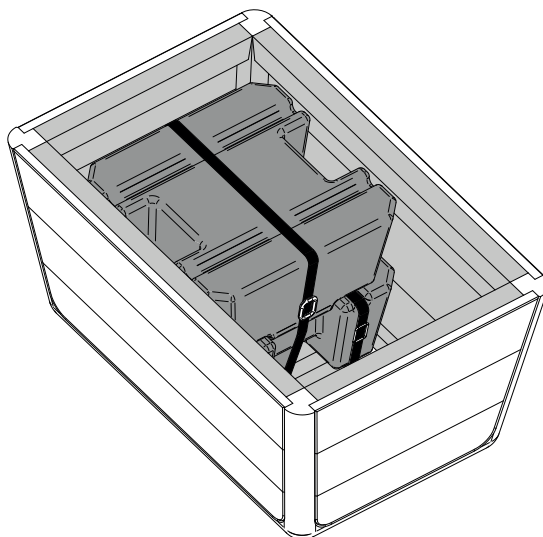


For safety and stability reasons secure tightly the second weight with the middle strap.

STEP 4: Cobi coffee table base installation: L-bracket (2x)

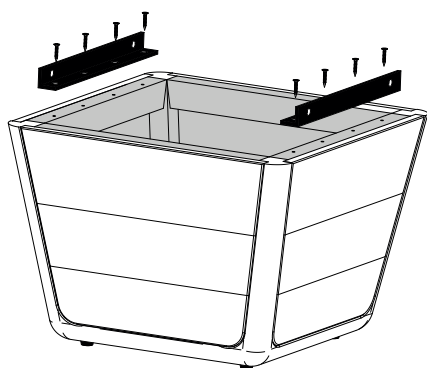

Place the metal brackets on each end of the teak base, aligning them with the holes. With a screwdriver, fasten the brackets to the base by using the 8 provided screws.



STEP 5: Cobi coffee table: assembly: positioning

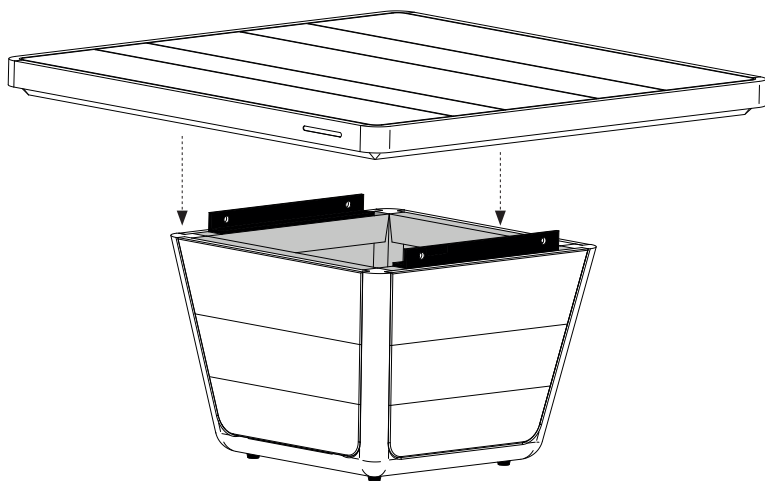

Minimum 2 persons are required to install easily the teak top on the teak base.

To align the teak top with the metal brackets, pay attention that the holes of the teak top are visible through the holes of the metal brackets.



STEP 6: Cobi coffee table: assembly: fastening

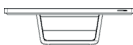

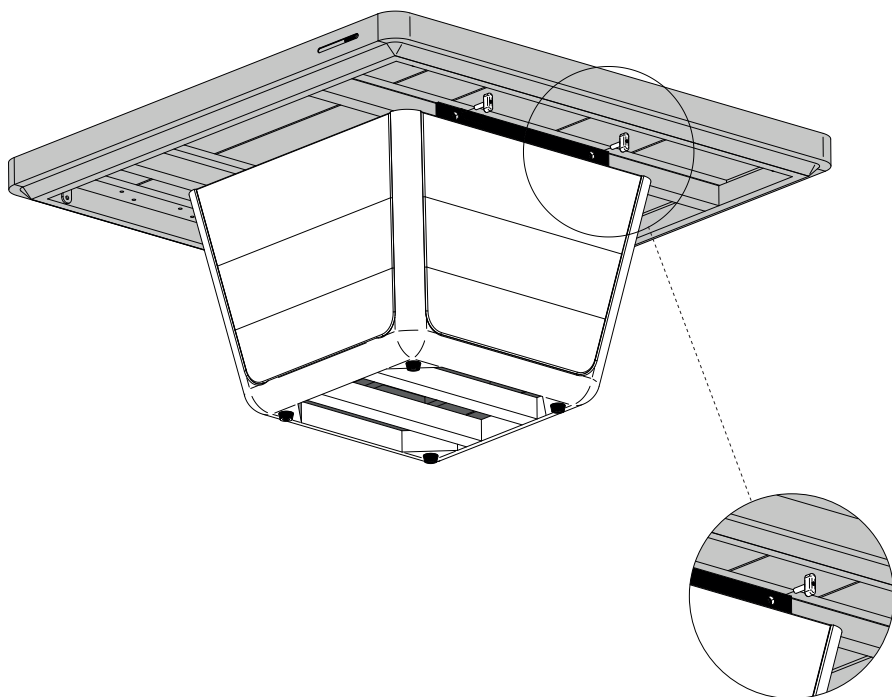

Using the 4 thumb screws to fasten easily the Cobi teak top to the base in teak.



STEP 7: Cobi coffee table: check

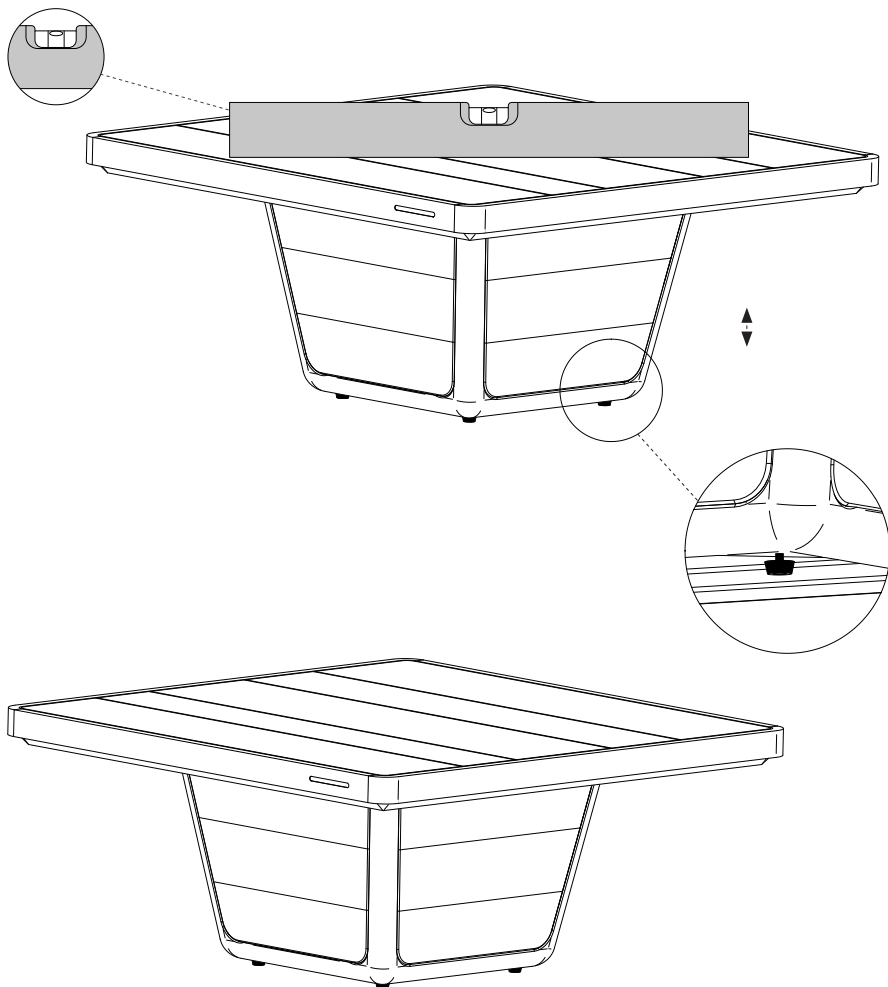

Adjust the feet caps by turning them to ensure the teak base is level and will not rock.

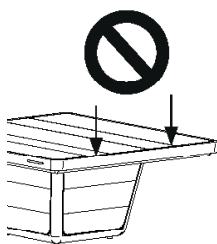


Safety

Do not use a high pressure cleaner to clean your furniture.
This may damage your furniture.



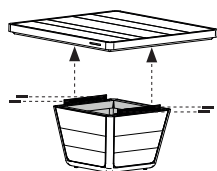
IMPORTANT:

IMPORTANT:

Do not lift the teak base with counterweight alone, always ask one or more persons for help.



IMPORTANT:

For easy moving, unscrew the 4 thumbscrews and remove coffee table top.
